

SAVE OUR RIDE-ON BUSES

TELL THE COUNCIL: "NO BUS CUTS!"

Montgomery County has proposed huge cuts to the RideOn bus system. We must stop these cuts! Last year, hundreds of bus riders told the County Council "No bus cuts!", and we stopped them. If you help, we can stop the cuts again.

WHAT BUS ROUTES WILL BE CUT?

RideOn will *eliminate* these bus routes:

- ◆ Weekdays: 3, 21, 30, 33, 36, 52, 53 and 81
- ◆ Saturdays: 14, 23, 29, 43, 45, 83, 98, L8, T2, and Z2
- ◆ Sundays: 29, 38, 83, L8, T2

RideOn will *cut parts* of these weekday bus routes:

- ◆ 7
- ◆ 22 (Elton Road extension)
- ◆ 32 (Woodrock extension)
- ◆ 43 (Falls Grove branch; also fewer rush hour trips)
- ◆ 22 (fewer rush hour trips)
- ◆ 93 (fewer rush hour trips)

YOU CAN HELP SAVE BUS SERVICE

- ① Tell the County Council to save RideOn. Either fill out the coupon below and mail it in an envelope to Council President Nancy Floreen, or send an e-mail to county.council@montgomerycountymd.gov. Be sure to include your home address in your e-mail.
- ② Make your voice heard in person. Come to the public meeting on Monday, Feb. 1, at 6:30 pm at 101 Monroe Street, Rockville (near the Rockville Metro) to show opposition to cuts.
